EASTERN NAMES 23 STUDENTS TO SPRING '07 HONOR LISTS

Eastern WV Community & Technical College named 23 students to its spring semester, 2007 student honor lists. Only two students—Teresa Smith of Parsons and Melissa Dawn Stump of Romney—earned President’s List honors this past spring, with a 4.0 cumulative grade-point-average (GPA) while carrying at least 12 credit-hours.
